- Please use computer generated scores sheets for the judges to sign off on at the conclusion of you meet These are to be the same forms that you send out to the Level Chairs, Score Tracker and State Chair
- All forms and electronic Scores are to be sent out within 48 hours of the conclusion of the Last Competition. WE have unfortunately waited for weeks this year from some of the met directors or have received on a different format that was asked for.
 - WE need these score in the formats we have previously ask for due to the fact that we are using this information numerous ways some of which are:
 - Gymnast tracking
 - Posting Scores on the Website
 - Communication of Level 9, 10 numbers to the National Office to help them determine age groups
 - Numbers of athletes competing and trends that develops over years. This will hopefully help us make better decisions
 - Clubs are using the internet postings for their Records (if you remember MEET Directors used to be required to send Sanctions and Scores to ALL the clubs that participated in their Meet). This has now bee eliminated
 - Coaches are using the information for INJURY PETITIONS
- Please go to the National R&P and note the distinction between Local and Invitational.
 - Some meet directors are sanctioning their meet as Local and then using their own age groups for awards. This is not allowed in a Local sanctioned meet. It would be my honor to represent you as your state Chairman once again. My mission for at least 20 years has been to continue representing the ILLINOIS GYMNASTICS COMMUNITY with FAIRNESS and QUALITY of service.

- **Elections will be done electronically via the USAG National Website. This is new and more will come to you on this later**

ARTICLE V- CRITERIA FOR NOMINATIONS (found on pg. 5 of the operating code)

All nominees must be:

- Professional Members of the Women's Program at least 21 years old and in good standing for a minimum of two (2) consecutive years immediately prior to the nomination.
A member in good standing is defined as a person who has complied with all aspects of the program as outlined in the Rules and Policies.

- Special circumstances involving residency criteria for any State or Regional Chairman position can be petitioned to the Regional Administrative Committee, in consultation with the National Administrative Committee Chairman (NACC), if necessary.

Prior to being placed on the ballot, all nominees must sign a document that verifies that they have read and understand the duties and responsibilities of the office for which they have been nominated. If resumes are to be submitted as part of the election process, they will be verified by the election commission that is receiving the nominations.

SECTION M- STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN (SACC) (pg. 6 operating code)

1. Must have been active within that State's program for a minimum of two (2) consecutive years.
2. It is strongly recommended that the candidates have
 - a. financial skills,
 - b. organizational skills,
 - c. communication skills,
 - d. a working knowledge of the program
 - e. a willingness to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of the position. (See Duties and Responsibilities - Operating Code)

ARTICLE VI- ELECTIONS AND TERM OF OFFICE

SECTION C - STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN (SACC)

1. State Administrative Committee Chairmen shall be elected by the Professional members of the Women's Program in their respective states.
2. They shall serve for two (2) years and be elected in the spring on even numbered years.
3. Elections to be completed by June 1. Term of office to begin July 1st.
4. Election Procedure
 - a. The Regional Administrative Committee Chairman publishes a description of the State Administrative Committee Chairman positions in the regional newsletter in order to solicit nominations. A minimum of one month must be given for the return of nominations. Nominees should have an opportunity to accept or decline nomination.
 - b. The Regional Administrative Committee Chairman will send out the ballots using the February USA Gymnastics Professional Membership listing.
 - c. An election commission shall be established in the region to tabulate the votes and verify the results. Election results should be verified in writing by the election commission.
 - d. Election commission shall consist of no less than three persons. The election commission Chairman shall be a non-USA Gymnastics member.

- e. Members of the election commission should be identified and published with the request for nominations.
- f. No signature will be required on ballots. Ballots will be made verifiable by pro numbers.
- g. Only official (valid) ballots will be counted (no copies).
- h. Ballots will be sent to the Chairman of the election commission.
- i. The Chairman shall be elected by majority (1 over 50%) of the votes cast.
- j. If no candidate receives a majority vote and a run-off is necessary, the run-off election will be between the two (2) candidates receiving the most votes. The run-off election will use the March USA Gymnastics Professional Membership listing.
- k. In the case of a tie in the run-off election or in an election with only two candidates, the Regional Chairman of the respective committee will vote to break the tie.
- l. If only one nomination for State Administrative Committee Chairman is received, the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman will cast one vote and the nominee will be elected by acclamation.
- m. If no nominations for State Administrative Committee Chairman have been received by the deadline, the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman will solicit nominations from the respective State Administrative Committee.
- n. Write in votes will not be allowed.
- o. The Regional Administrative Committee Chairman shall send a copy of the verified vote count to each candidate in each respective election, upon request of the candidate.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE:

IX. STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

The State Administrative Committee Chairman is responsible for the overall organization of all designated qualifying events and programs within their State. The State Administrative Committee Chairman shall work in close cooperation with the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman, Regional Elite Committee Chairman, Regional Junior Olympic Committee Chairman and the Regional Technical Committee Chairman to effectuate State programs. Any problems that cannot be solved by the State Administrative Committee Chairman should be submitted to the appropriate regional personnel.

1. Be directly responsible to their Regional Administrative Committee Chairman.
2. Serve as a voting member of the Regional Administrative Committee.
3. Serve as the USA Gymnastics Women's Program consultant for that State and answer any correspondence directed to that office.
4. Send copies of correspondence to the appropriate regional personnel.
5. Be responsible for overseeing the Junior Olympic Sectional and State Championships in their state, at least once per year.
6. Conduct the annual state meeting of Women's Program Professional members.
7. Determine the site and event director for Jr. Olympic Qualifying Meets, Sectional and State Championships. This may be done by bids or solicitations.
8. Assure that these competitions follow USA Gymnastics Rules and Policies.
9. Attend the State Championships as the USA Gymnastics representative.
10. Provide State Administrative Committee representation at all sectional meets and above.
11. Make recommendations to the Regional Technical Committee Chairman and the Regional Junior Olympic Committee Chairman concerning petitions into the Regional Competitions.
12. Establish procedures to raise operating funds for the state, if necessary. The State Administrative Committee Chairman may, with the approval of the State Administrative Committee, determine and/or collect competition and/or club fees for the purpose of raising operating funds for the region. All fees will be retained in the State account for use as determined by the State Administrative Committee.
13. Maintain a state checking account and file quarterly financial reports with the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman, as required in the "Financial Reporting Procedures" document.
14. Shall be accountable for all state funds.
15. Provide for a State Administrative Committee, the number and type of positions to be determined by each state, in order to best serve the needs of the program in the state.
16. Inform the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman and other appropriate Regional Administrative Committee members of any actions contrary to the Rules and Policies of USA Gymnastics. The Regional office shall inform the appropriate National Chairman of any problems. After due investigation, corrective measures shall be recommended by the National Administrative Committee Chairman.
17. Publish a newsletter as necessary (or as directed by the Regional Administrative Committee

Chairman). This newsletter shall include new information related to the USA Gymnastics program, results of competitions, dates of events, official bulletins from committees.

18. Send state newsletters to the membership of the state, and to the USA Gymnastics Jr. Olympic Program Manager, Jr. Olympic Program Committee Chairman, National Administrative Committee Chairman, and the National Technical Committee Chairman.

At the most recent Executive Committee meeting program was directed by legal counsel regarding non-citizen athlete participation at our Junior Olympic Program events.

Please publish the following statement on your web-sites and your newsletters. Thanks.

Updated Ruling for competitors who are non-citizens living and training in the US.

Effective immediately, non-citizen athletes who meet the above criteria will be eligible to compete and receive awards for all USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic sanctioned events including State, Regional, East/West and JO Nationals.

If a non-citizen athlete places in the top four (4) AA at JO Nationals, she will receive the award for her All-Around placement, however; she is not eligible to become a member of the US JO National Team. In this instance, the next US citizen in rank order will be placed on the JO National Team.

It's here! - Introductory Coach Membership

USA Gymnastics is offering the Introductory coach membership for all Level 1-3 coaches. All Introductory coaches must become safety certified. They must also complete the Introductory Coach application and keep on file. The form can be located online in the forms section. This lower cost alternative allows coaches of Levels 1-3 with current safety certification to participate in sanctioned events. The membership is modeled after the Introductory Membership and is available for online registration.

Here is how easy it is to register:

1. Locate the Introductory Coach application in the Forms section at <http://www.usa-gymnastics.org/>, complete it and keep on file.
2. Go to the Member Services link on the website, locate the *register now* link and then the link to register for the Introductory Coach membership.
3. After you complete the form, you will receive your user id and password to register for and complete the online safety course, which is \$65.00.
4. Upon completion and processing of your online safety course results, your Introductory Coach Membership will be released and a membership card will be e-mailed to you.

Some issues to consider and be covered in more depth in later articles

In this article I shall, in Olympic order, list some constant technical problems that cause problems with performances at the compulsory and optional levels. It is my hope that you will e-mail me your thoughts on any or all of these articles become interactive.

Carl Lewis, in his last Olympic (of five) fouled on three of his finals runs in the long jump (which he won anyway). If precise runs were difficult for Carl **then it is possible** that our young gymnasts have problems creating fast and consistent runs. Let me know what you see.

After reviewing some NCAA vault finals performances several years ago (pre-Yurchenko) it seemed like all of the girls had inefficient jumps. By that I mean that their legs seemed to be, to some extent, pushing them backwards. Let me know what you see.

Uneven Bars seems to be the hardest event on which to develop skills (beam being the hardest on which to execute skills). This is painfully evident when the girls show up on high school teams, but the bar start values seem to lag those on the other events. Let me know what you see.

The flic-flac on the balance beam may be the most important single skill in all of optional gymnastics for the majority of competitors both psychologically and technically. **It might even be** the skill that causes many kids to quit the sport after level 6, 7. Let me know what you see.

One of the major disconnects between coaching knowledge and gymnasts' execution may well be in front tumbling. I believe that most coaches have sound concepts of front tumbling but the kids keep having trouble executing front series. If Nastia is doing quad twists backwards why should lower level kids have such trouble with even a full twist forward? Let me know what you see.

In future articles, after I receive your emails, I shall write about each one of these issues. Please share your thoughts! If there are more pressing items to analyze please let me know that also.
