Nia Dennis was born February 23, 1999 and began her gymnastics career at Buckeye Gymnastics. As a Junior Olympic gymnast, Nia became the National Beam Champion and was 3<sup>rd</sup> All-Around in the Junior A division of the 2011 National Championships. The following year Nia was 2<sup>nd</sup> on Floor and 5<sup>th</sup> All-Around at the 2012 Nastia Liukin Cup. Nia continued progressing to be able to be on the Elite National team from 2012-2016.
